Located on the ground floor of the hotel is The Punters Bar, your ‘local’ while in the Northern Territory.

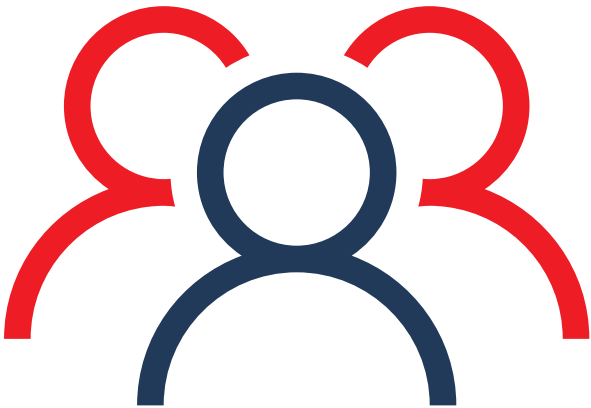
Our People

We invest in the improvement of our company culture, our people, our education practices, and work environments and are proudly listed and certified as a Great Place to Work®.



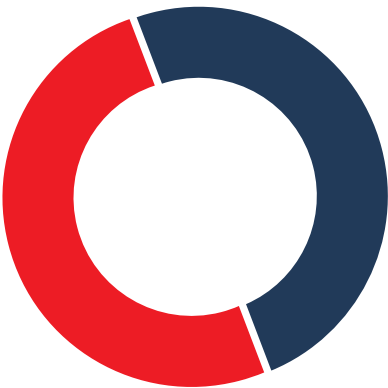

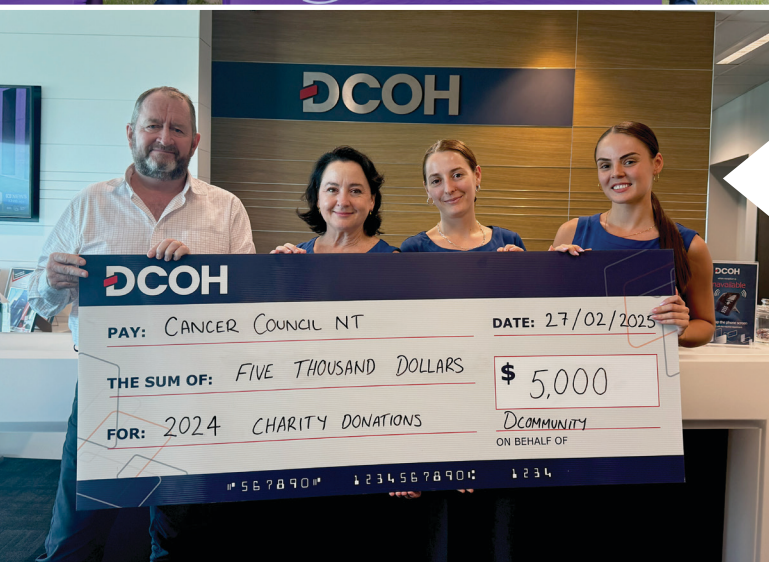
DCOH Giving Back
